- 2. The reported securities are included within 4,081 Units purchased by Mr. Anderson for \$6.125 per Unit in the Issuer's IPO. Each Unit consists of one share of Common Stock, one five-year tradeable warrant to purchase one share of Common Stock at an exercise price of \$7.35 per share, and one five-year non-tradeable warrant to purchase one share of Common Stock at an exercise price of \$7.656 per share.
